### 2020 Symposium Meals Program Guidelines

Dear Friends of the Symposium:

Thank you so much for all your past support of the Nashua International Sculpture Symposium.

In this year of change and uncertainty, the Symposium Board of Directors has decided to conduct the 2020 Symposium from August 20<sup>th</sup> to September 12<sup>th</sup> ... now all within pandemic guidelines.

Truly a community project, the public is still encouraged to sign up to provide lunch or dinner for the sculptors during their three-week stay. However, rather than providing family style meals cooked in home kitchens, this year a list of participating restaurants is scheduled so that individual meals can be cooked and packaged in commercial kitchens.

To sign up for a meal, visit our website (<http://www.nashuasculpturesymposium.org/table>). For each day, the calendar states which restaurant has agreed to make the meals. The cost of each lunch will be \$52 including tax and gratuity. The cost of each dinner will be \$72 including tax and gratuity.

It's very important that you sign up directly on our website so that we can mark you down for the date and meal you are providing. You will receive a confirmation email from us once you do so.

From here, the process is for you to contact the restaurant two days in advance and pay for the meals. You will then pick up the meals on your designated day (12:00 noon for lunch, 6:00 PM for dinner) at the restaurant listed on the calendar and bring them to the worksite at The Picker Artists, 3 Pine Street in Nashua. The restaurant's contact name and phone number are listed on the calendar as well. If you cannot pick up the meals yourself, please call Gail at 603.930.5080 and we will make arrangements.

Provisions are made for you to join the sculptors for the meal if you choose and if the weather permits for outside dining. Two 10' x 10' tents will be set up for eating outside unless it is particularly heavy rain or wind. You can order additional meals from the restaurant or bring your own meal.

Another option is also available to contribute monetarily to the meals at any level you wish, rather than signing up for a specific meal. Click on the "donate" button in the top right corner of our website to help support the meals program. We appreciate any and all contributions very much.

We are grateful to you and many others throughout the community for your ongoing support. The Symposium truly would not exist if not for the generosity of Nashua's residents and businesses.
